Having consulted with Marine Scotland Science , Jim McKie and Mark Christie I can state that in principal we are content that the proposal by BOWL to carry out the Salmon Smolt study on the Berriedale would fully discharge the requirements of condition 30 of your S36 consent regarding the requirements of the Salmon and trout strategy. However, the condition goes on to state that the extent and nature of the company's participation is to be agreed by the Scottish Ministers in consultation with the MFRAG. As you are aware we are still awaiting feedback from both the developers and SNCBs on the terms of reference of the MFRAG. Once done we would hope to constitute the MFRAG quite quickly and can then consult with its members as required by the condition.
