CONSENT UNDER SECTION 36 THE ELECTRICITY ACT 1989 (AS AMENDED) AND A MARINE LICENCE UNDER PART 4 OF THE MARINE (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010 AND MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009 TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE THE BEATRICE OFFSHORE WIND FARM AND TRANSMISSION WORKS, OUTER MORAY FIRTH.

On the 30th March 2016 Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) received a letter from NATS Safeguarding (Ref: W(F)8575) confirming that the Primary Radar Mitigation Scheme (“PRMS”) agreed with Beatrice Offshore Windfarm Limited under a legal agreement, has now been implemented to NATS En-Route PLC (“NERL”) satisfaction. This letter also confirms NERL’s agreement that the turbine blades can be fitted to the turbines at Beatrice Offshore Windfarm.

Implementation of the PRMS fulfils the requirements of, and is sufficient to discharge, condition 23 of the Section 36 Consent. MS LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, therefore confirms that condition 23 of the Section 36 Consent is now discharged.
