Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Construction Programme for the Seagreen Alpha and Bravo Offshore Windfarm project.

The MCA would expect to see reference to the Emergency Response Cooperation Plan (ERCoP) under the emergency arrangements part of Programme, which only appears to focus on the reporting requirements for the MOD Danger Area.

In addition, we would expect the Programme to include a reference that contractor and subcontractor vessels will comply with all relevant maritime safety related legislation, and any required survey, certification and inspection arrangements will be discussed and agreed with the relevant MCA Marine Office in advance of works commencing.

The MCA has no further comments to make on this occasion and is content that our requirements will be addressed through other relevant post-consent documentation.

Thank you for your e-mail correspondence dated 14<sup>th</sup> April 2020 relating to the Construction Programme (CoP) submitted by Seagreen Wind Energy Limited (SWEL) for the Seagreen Alpha and Seagreen Bravo offshore wind farm sites.

Northern Lighthouse Board have no objections to the CoP, and are content that it satisfies the requirements of condition 9 of the Section 36 consents, condition 3.2.2.3 of the OTA Marine Licence and condition 3.1.1 of the Alternative Landfall Cable Installation Methodology Marine Licence.

It is noted in Section 4.1 of the Barry Buddon Firing Range Complex: MOD Communications Protocol that marker buoys will be established to physical demarcate the firing range Danger Area so as to prevent unauthorised entry by vessels. It is requested that SWEL liaise with NLB with regard to these buoys, so as to ensure that the correct Statutory Sanction and charting processes are followed.
