Thank you for your letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> August 2012 applying for consents under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 and Marine Licenses under Part 4 (Sections 65 and 66) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 and Section 20 of the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010 to construct and operate the Telford, Stevenson and MacColl Wind Farms and associated Transmission Infrastructure in the Outer Moray Firth.

Subject to the points below being actioned, the above applications will be formally accepted by Marine Scotland.

- **1.** Ensure the 8 locations where the ES is available for inspection (as listed in the in the press notice) plus the Scottish Government Library receive a hard copy of the Transparencies issued to the Highland Council.
- 2. On the Applications and ES DVD the pdf files for each application form do not show the information contained on the additional sheets (Section 5b, Section 8a quantities, Figures showing location and list of coordinates) as per the hard copies provided in the application. Please update the files and re-issue to consultees. Future copies of the DVD should also contain this information.
- 3. MORL response to MS comments on ES Gate Check submission 2 points from the Gate Check letter have not been addressed, and 1 point has been addressed but now contains errors. As follows:
  - Volume 2, preface xxxiv Hydrology, geology and Hydrogeology Plates are now numbered incorrectly. They are listed as 3.6-1 and 3.6-2, but should be 3.7-1 and 3.7-2
  - Volume 9, Appendix 3.7A, page 3 The list of figures is still incomplete, i.e. 1 of, 2 of, 3 of etc.
  - Volume 10, Appendix 4.7A, page 5 Appendix C is still missing from the contents list.

The draft notice to publicise the application in the press is approved and subject to the points above being addressed, can be placed in the relevant publications as per the proposed dates already discussed. Marine Scotland will now forward the Environmental Statement to internal consultees and write to external consultees inviting each of them to respond by 27<sup>th</sup> September 2012. Only the Local Planning Authority of Aberdeenshire Council — Banff and Buchan Area will be given until 16<sup>th</sup> December 2012 to respond. A list detailing the external consultees invited to respond is attached.

Invoices in respect to the fees for each application to the Scottish Government will follow shortly.
