Anchors and chains will be laid by boat and the pontoon will be constructed from the shore by assembling the 500 x 500 mm 'PD3' cubes consecutively to create a pontoon that is 2m wide and 60m long and which incorporates a hammerhead of 5m x 2.5m with safety rails and cleats, as per attached drawing.

During the winter, when the pontoon is not in use, it will be dismantled and stored ashore securely on the land owned by the applicant. The removal procedure will be a direct reversal of the installation procedure. The pontoon cubes, safety railings and mooring gear will be visually and physically inspected and serviced prior to re-installation in the spring of each year.

The pontoon will allow Skye Marine Limited to expand its marine eco-tourism activities for wildlife watching/conservation/monitoring and for seeing and discovering about the many historical places of interest in the area covered by the activities, namely in and around Lochs Greshornish, Snizort, Sznirrot Beag and Diubaig. It will also provide further local employment + opportunities for local residents of Skye to undertake recognized RYA courses. It also ensures a safe and stable platform for the the embarkation and disembarkation of passengers of all ages and abilities at any state of the tide.

Furthermore, it will allow the local community to benefit from increased marine tourism as it also provides a landing stage for visiting (internationally-flagged) yachts, which will be promoted through pilot guides, etc. - a facility that is currently lacking.

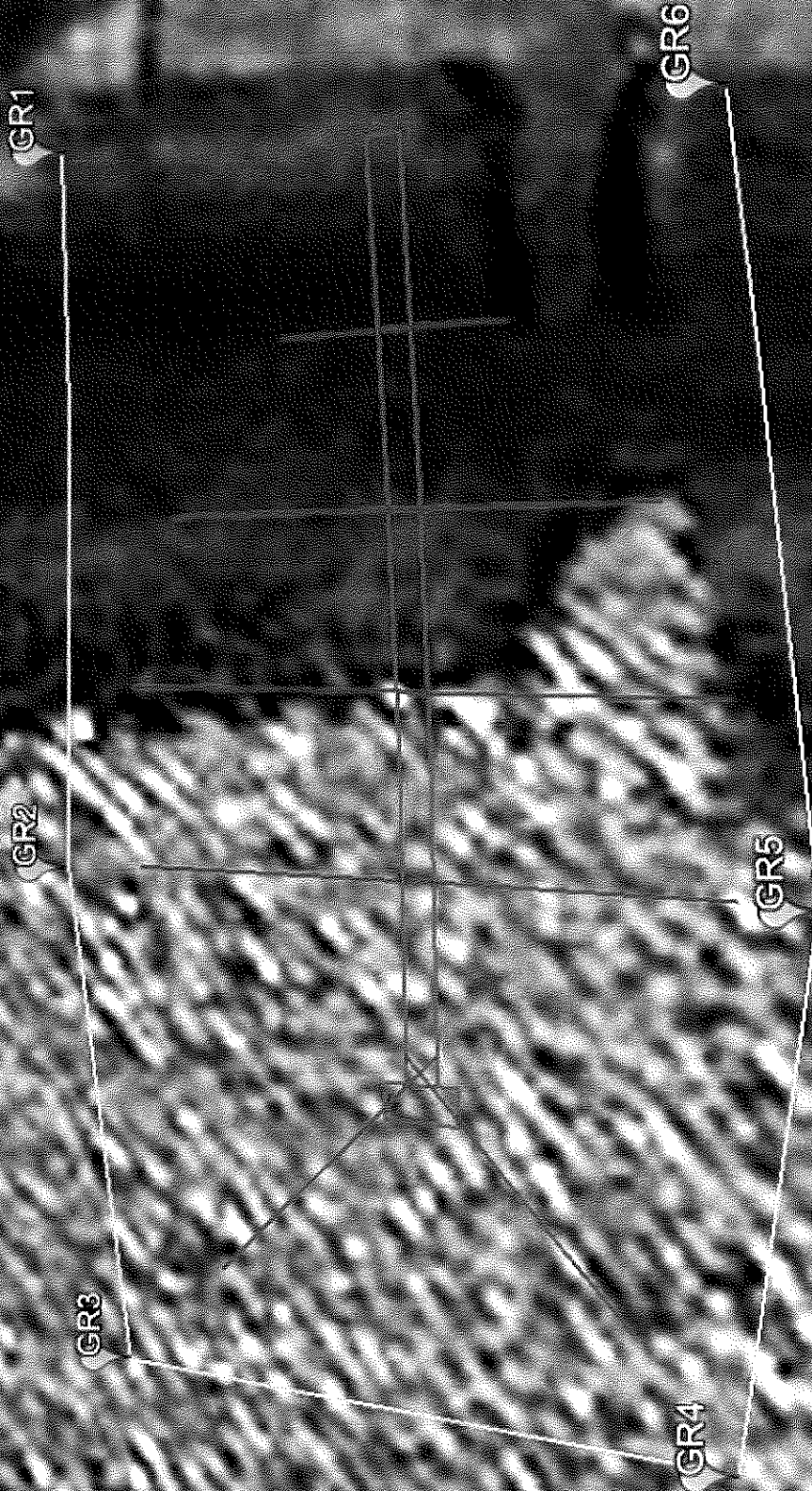
