AGREE PLANNING BASELINE - PORT A CHLAIDH WEST, LOCH NA KEAL, ISLE OF MULL

I can confirm that your existing oyster farm at Port a Chlaidh West has planning permission under the Town and Country Planning (Marine Fish Farms Permitted Development) (Scotland) Order 2011. This permission as you know, allows you to continue to use your current equipment in its current location but does not include a defined planning boundary.

To support your proposed planning application to expand your current oyster site it has been necessary to agree an informal planning baseline between the Council and yourself. The map below presents what is agreed as your current planning area which is based on the location and use of your existing oyster farm and your current Crown Estate lease. This planning boundary should be starting point used in any planning application to amend your current permission.
