## Comments

The Applicant has advised the following:

With regard to Test 1 there are several different purposes for which an EPS licence can be granted including, under Regulation 44(2)(e) of the Habitat Regulations for 'preserving public health or public safety or other imperative reasons of overriding public interest including those of a social or economic nature and beneficial consequences of primary importance for the environment'.

NatureScot Guidance states that, when determining an EPS Licence application, it will be taken into account whether an activity or development is required to meet, or contribute to meeting, a specific need such as maintaining the environment of Scotland's people (including sustainable development and renewable or green energy), complying with national planning policies and supporting economic or social development (including nationally important infrastructure development projects and employment).

The proposed activity addresses a specific need in relation to the improvement of existing Harbour infrastructure at Grutness Harbour in order to facilitate the new Fair Isle lifeline ferry.

If the applicant are unable to carry out the improvement works, the new ferry will be unable to use the Harbour as the infrastructure is not suitable. The new ferry will provide a lifeline link to the Fair Isle for decades to come as the existing one has come to the end of its serviceable life. By not carrying out the improvement works and employing a new ferry, this would have a severe socio-economic impact on the people and businesses of the Fair Isle as both travel and supplies will be severely limited.

Regulation 44(3)(a) of the Habitat Regulations requires the Scottish Ministers to be satisfied that there is no
satisfactory alternative before an EPS Licence can be issued for the Licensable Operations.
In this instance, the applicant considered alternatives to driven piles, bored piles were considered, however this was discounted as the piles through the open tidal section of the quay would require steel pile casings, this would only result in a marginal reduction in the disturbance and would also introduce additional and longer duration construction activities. This could increase the overall environmental impact of the works. Not carrying out the works was not considered a suitable alternative as this would result in serious socio-economic challenges for the community of the Fair Isle.
