Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed viewpoints. From my perspective these are the six viewpoints most appropriate for effects on travellers and residents. I do however believe that consideration should be given to including a visualisation from Duncansby Head given that this is a key visitor attraction within a Special Landscape Area. I accept that the ES did not consider the impact as significant from here but it is nonetheless important.

Notwithstanding the new guidance from SNH on visualisations, The Highland Council require visualisations to its Standards. The development would be particularly suited to the Council's viewer system —which can avoid the need for costly prints. The company will be familiar with this process as it was used for the proposal previously. This also has the advantage that a direct comparison should be able to be made.
