## **KOWL Marine Licence Application Public Consultation Responses**

Please accept this letter as confirmation that KOWL believe that all comments received during the public consultation period for the Kincardine Offshore Wind Farm Marine Licence and Section 36 Application have been acknowledged, responded to via further consultation with the consultee, and addressed as appropriate.

Regarding certain specific consultees, as agreed in the meeting with MS LOT (15<sup>th</sup> September 2016), KOWL have conducted further engagement with the statutory consultees SNH (telephone call 15<sup>th</sup> September), Aberdeenshire Council (meeting 20<sup>th</sup> September) and Aberdeen City Council (meeting 21<sup>st</sup> September) to confirm their requirements have been addressed and are covered in the ES Additional Information Addendum. Last correspondence with RSPB was in form of formal response and KOWL believe this satisfy their concerns as no further objections or comments has been received. It has not been possible to communicate with Aedan Smith at RSPB in person since the 15<sup>th</sup> September, but previous meetings with RSPB to discuss KOWL's response have been minuted and provided to MS-LOT.
