**MARINE LICENCE UNDER PART 4 OF THE MARINE (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010 AND MARINE AND COASTAL ACCESS ACT 2009 TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE THE BEATRICE OFFSHORE WIND FARM TRANSMISSION WORKS, OUTER MORAY FIRTH.**

Thank you for your correspondence dated 21<sup>st</sup> December 2016 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) give their written approval to the revised Offshore Transmission Works Cable Plan (“OfTW CaP”) (Revision 3.0, issued 20/12/2016). Acceptance of the OfTW CaP will satisfy the requirements of condition 3.2.2.10 of the Offshore Transmission Works (“OfTW”) marine licence (licence number: 04461/16/0).

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, have consulted with the Joint Nature Conservation Committee, Scottish Natural Heritage, the Maritime and Coastguard Agency, Scottish Fishermen’s Federation, Marine Scotland Science and Moray Offshore Renewables Ltd, and can confirm that the submitted OfTW CaP fulfils the requirements of, and is sufficient to discharge, condition 3.2.2.10 of the OfTW marine licence, subject to it being fully implemented,.

Any updates or amendments made to this OfTW CaP by the Company must be submitted in writing by the Company to the Scottish Ministers for their written approval.
