Thank you for your correspondence dated 21<sup>st</sup> March 2017 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operation Team ("MS-LOT") give their written approval to the revised Plan for Construction Activities 2017 (Revision 03, Document Ref: C178-HYS-Z-GA-0001\_03) ("the Construction Plan") submitted by Hywind (Scotland) Limited.

MS-LOT, have consulted with the Joint Nature Conservation Committee, Scottish Natural Heritage, Scottish Environment Protection Agency, Maritime and Coastguard Agency, Northern Lighthouse Board, Aberdeenshire Council, Marine Scotland Science, Scottish Fishermen's Federation, UK Chamber of Shipping, Civil Aviation Authority, Ministry of Defence and Historic Environment Scotland.

MS LOT, as the Licensing Authority, can confirm that, subject to it being fully implemented, the submitted Construction Plan fulfils the requirements of, and is sufficient to discharge the following conditions of the Hywind Scotland Pilot Park Project Marine Licence (Licence Number: 05515/15/0):

Vessel Management Plan	Any changes in the details supplied must be notified to the Licensing Authority, as soon as practicable, prior to any such change being implemented in the construction of operations of the Works.
