Thank you for your correspondence dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2016 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) give their written approval to the revised Navigational and Safety Plan (“NSP”), updated to include the Emergency Response Cooperation Plan (“ERCoP”) (Revision 5.0, issued 02/02/2017). Acceptance of the NSP and ERCoP will satisfy the requirements of condition 18 of the Section 36 Consent and the requirements of condition 3.2.2.9 of the Offshore Transmission Works (OfTW) Marine Licence (licence number: 04461/16/0).

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, have consulted with the Marine and Coastguard Agency (“MCA”) and the Northern Lighthouse Board (“NLB”) and can confirm that the submitted NSP and ERCoP fulfils the requirements of, and is sufficient to discharge condition 18 of the section 36 Consent and discharge condition 3.2.2.9 of the OfTW Marine Licence (licence number: 04461/16/0), subject to it being fully implemented.

Any updates or amendments made to this NSP or ERCoP by the Company, must be submitted in writing by the Company to the Scottish Ministers for their written approval.
