MARINE LICENCE TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE THE HYWIND SCOTLAND PILOT PARK WINDFARM IN THE BUCHAN DEEP, OFF PETERHEAD.

Thank you for your correspondence dated 12th April and 5th May 2017 providing details of steps taken to satisfy the requirements of condition 3.2.2.15. of the Hywind Scotland Pilot Park Marine Licence (Licence Number: 05515/16/0), including;

- The submission of an 'Application for Statutory Sanction to Alter / Exhibit" form to the Northern Lighthouse Board ("NLB").
- The completion of Notices to Mariners to ensure local mariners, fishermen's organisations and HM Coastguard, in this case the National Maritime Operations Centre, are made fully aware of the Licensable Activity.
- Confirmation of intention to ensure promulgation of the Works in the Kingfisher Fortnightly Bulletin, to inform the Sea Fish Industry of the vessel routes, the timings and the location of the Works and of the relevant operations

At a meeting between Hywind (Scotland) Limited ("Hywind") and the UK Hydrographic Office ("UKHO") on 6th April 2017, the UKHO confirmed that they had received sufficient information regarding the upcoming works (i.e. the location of the Suction Anchor positions). As agreed, MS-LOT expect Hywind to issue further information regarding the location and height of the FTWs to the UKHO as soon as possible.

Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") can confirm that the correspondence submitted by Hywind on the 12th April and 5th May 2017 and referred to above, fulfils the requirements of, and is sufficient to discharge, condition 3.2.2.15. Navigation and Aviation Safety and Charting of the Marine Licence (Licence Number: 05515/16/0).
