Thank you for your correspondence dated 21st March 2017 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) discharge condition 3.2.1.3. of the Hywind Scotland Pilot Park Marine Licence (Licence Number: 05515/16/0).

MS-LOT, as the Licensing Authority on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, have consulted with the Scottish Fishermen Federation (“SFF”) on the submitted Plan for Construction Activities 2017 (“the Construction Plan”) (Revision 03, Document Ref: C178-HYS-Z-GA-0001_03) which included the Fisheries Management and Mitigation Strategy (“FMMS”).

MS LOT can confirm that, subject to it being fully implemented, the submitted Construction Plan fulfils the requirements of, and is sufficient to discharge, condition 3.2.1.3. Fisheries Management and Mitigation Strategy (“FMMS”) of the Marine Licence (Licence Number: 05515/16/0).
