**ELECTRICITY ACT 1989**

*The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017*

Thank you for your correspondence dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2017 detailing the events leading to Aberdeen Offshore Wind Farm Limited (“AOWFL”) meeting the requirements of, and requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) discharge, condition 6 of the Section 36 Consent, relating to the Decommissioning Programme, as provided below:

- Aberdeen Offshore Windfarm Limited (“AOWFL”) commenced the 30 day formal consultation process on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2017, in accordance with the Section 105 notice issued to AOWFL by BEIS
- AOWFL issued the Decommissioning Programme to MS-LOT (the appropriate authority) on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2017

Therefore, MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, can confirm that the events detailed above fulfil the requirements of, and are sufficient to discharge, condition 6 of the Section 36 Consent.
