CONSENT UNDER SECTION 36 OF THE ELECTRICITY ACT 1989 (AS AMENDED) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE EUROPEAN OFFSHORE WIND DEPLOYMENT CENTRE ELECTRICITY GENERATING STATION, ABERDEEN BAY, APPROXIMATELY 2KM EAST OF BLACKDOG, ABERDEENSHIRE WITH A MAXIMUM GENERATION CAPACITY OF 100 MW.

CONDITION 10, BLACK DOG FIRING RANGE MANAGEMENT PLAN (“MANAGEMENT PLAN”)
