CONSENT UNDER THE MARINE (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010 PART 4 MARINE LICENSING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE EUROPEAN OFFSHORE WIND DEPLOYMENT CENTRE ELECTRICITY GENERATING STATION, ABERDEEN BAY, APPROXIMATELY 2KM EAST OF BLACKDOG, ABERDEENSHIRE WITH A MAXIMUM GENERATION CAPACITY OF 100 MW.

Thank you for your correspondence dated 19th September 2017 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") confirms Aberdeen Offshore Windfarm Limited's ("AOWFL's) compliance with condition 3.2.1.5 of Marine Licence (licence number: 04461/16/0) in relation to the requirement to apply for a Statutory Sanction to Alter / Exhibit to establish four lit navigation buoys marking the construction area of the AOWFL.

In your correspondence, you have included a letter from the Northern Lighthouse Board ("NLB"). This letter states *'The Statutory Sanction of the Commissioners of Northern lighthouses is hereby conveyed to Aberdeen Offshore Windfarm Limited to exhibit the new buoy stations...'*.

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, can confirm that the submitted information provided confirms that AOWFL is in compliance with condition 3.2.1.5 of Marine Licence, licence number: 04461/16/0 in relation to the requirement to apply for a Statutory Sanction to Alter / Exhibit to establish four lit navigation buoys to mark the construction area of the AOWFL.
