Further to our letter dated 10th January 2018, the Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) confirm that no further action is required in relation to condition 3.2.3.5 of the Offshore Transmission Works (“OTW”) Marine Licence (licence number: 04461/16/0) and condition 3.2.2.3 of the Offshore Wind Farm (“OWF”) Marine Licence (licence number: 04462/16/0), in so far the requirement to obtaining written approval from the Office of Communications (“OfCom”) prior to the installation or use of radio or radar beacons operating in the marine frequency bands.

Should any additional radio or radar beacons operating in the marine frequency bands be installed or used on the Works, prior written approval must be obtained from OfCom.
