
Figure 13.17: Ladyloan Signal Tower (HB21230): cumulative wirelines, photomontage and setting images


Figure 13.18: Dunbar Battery (Canmore 57657): cumulative wirelines and photomontage


Figure 13.19: St Andrews Links (GDL00080): cumulative wirelines, photomontage and setting images


Figure 13.20: Cambo Estate (GDL00344): Setting images


Figure 15.1: Map of local study area






























Cumulative wireline and Photomontage from St Andrews East Scores (above harbour) looking towards the Offshore Wind Farm (Source: LUC)






Cumulative wireline and Photomontage from Ladyloan Signal Tower looking towards the Offshore Wind Farm (Source: LUC)


