The Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017 (as amended)

Thank you for your correspondence of 28th March 2018 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") give their written approval to Revision 7 (issued 27/03/2018) of the Construction Method Statement ("CMS") (Document Reference: ABE-ENV-DB-0014. Rev. 7).

A previous version of the CMS (Revision 4, issued 25/09/2017) received multi-stage and regulatory consent from MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, in a letter dated 9th October 2017 and deemed it sufficient to fully discharge condition 13 of the Section 36 consent, subject to it being fully implemented.

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, can confirm that based on the information detailed in Revision 7 of the CMS, that Aberdeen Offshore Wind Farm Limited ("AOWFL") is in compliance with condition 13 of the Section 36 consent.

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers therefore confirm their approval of the revised CMS (Revision 7, issued 27/03/2017). Any further updates or amendments made to the CMS by the Company, must be submitted in writing by the Company to the Scottish Ministers for their written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.
