MARINE (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010, PART 4 MARINE LICENSING

MARINE LICENCE 06573/18/2;

Thank you for your correspondence dated 19th March 2018 providing Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") with the "Licence Return Form for Marine Construction Works" in line with condition 3.2.1.5 – '*Nature and quantity of removed substances and objects*' of the LiDAR Removal Marine Licence ("licence number: 06573/18/2") for Aberdeen Offshore Windfarm Limited ("AOWFL") at European Offshore Windfarm Deployment Centre ("EOWDC").

At section 7 of the FEP05 form "*Nature and Quantity of all Materials Deposited or Removed Below Mean High Water Springs*" you have stated that "No materials were deposited" and that all temporary deposits (including the FORECAST Floating LiDAR and associated mooring system and anchors) were removed from the seabed.

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, can confirm that the requirements of condition 3.2.1.5, '*Nature and quantity of removed substances and objects*', of the LiDAR Removal Marine Licence ("licence number: 06573/18/2") are fully satisfied and therefore the condition is now discharged.
