MARINE LICENCE NUMBER: 05914/18/0, Condition 3.1.9 Fluorinated greenhouse gases

Thank you for your correspondence of 2nd May 2018, requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) give their written confirmation that the requirements of Condition 3.1.9 of the Marine Licence (licence number: 05914/18/0), ‘*Fluorinated greenhouse gases*’, has been fully satisfied and the condition can be discharged.

In your correspondence, you provided a Chemicals and Fluorinated Gases Report (KOWL-REP-0004005) which confirmed that ‘*At the time of writing no fluorinated greenhouse gases have been identified as being utilised within the works.*’

An updated Chemicals and Fluorinated Gases Report must be submitted to the Scottish Ministers for their written approval no less than one calendar month, prior to the Commencement of Works relative to future tranches of the entire Development. In respect of such approval, if granted, and if appropriate a further Discharge letter will be issued.

MS-LOT can confirm, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers and based on the confirmation that no fluorinated greenhouse gases will be used within the Works, that Condition 3.1.9 of the Kincardine Floating Offshore Windfarm Marine Licence (Licence Number:05914/18/0) has been complied with in so far as it relates to Tranche 1 of the Development.
