Aberdeen Offshore Windfarm Limited ("AOWFL") is proposing to remove the floating LiDAR device from the location of the European Offshore Wind Deployment Centre (EOWDC) in early February 2018. In compliance with condition 3.2.4.4 of the Floating LiDAR Device, Marine Licence (number: 06436/17/0) which states:

"3.2.4.4 Removal of the Works

This licence does not permit the Removal of the Works, for which a separate marine licence is required.

The Licensee must, no later than 3 months prior to any proposed removal works, submit a plan for the Removal of the Works, in writing, to the Licensing Authority, along with a marine licence application for the Removal of the Works.

Removal of the Works must not occur until the Licensing Authority has given its prior written approval to the plan and issued a marine licence.

Reason: *To ensure that removal of works is carried out under an appropriate licence, in accordance with s.29(3)(a) of the 2010 Act."*

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the potential impact of the above proposed works on the safety of navigation.

The Marine Licence application and supporting documentation have been considered by Navigation Safety Branch. On this occasion, the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA) has no objection to consent being granted provided all maritime safety legislation is followed and the conditions/advisories below are applied:

Conditions:

1. The Licencee must ensure that local mariners and fishermen's organisations are made fully aware of the activity through local notices to mariners.
2. The Licencee must ensure that HM Coastguard, in this case nmoccontroller@hmcg.gov.uk, The National Maritime Operations Centre is made aware of the works prior to commencement.
3. The Licencee must notify the UK Hydrographic Office to permit the promulgation of maritime safety information and updating of nautical charts and publications through the national Notice to Mariners system.

In addition, the following advice should be provided to the applicant to facilitate the proposed works:

Advisories:

1. If in the opinion of the Secretary of State the assistance of a Government Department, including the broadcast of navigational warnings, is required in connection with the works or to deal with any emergency arising from the failure to mark and light the works as required by the consent or to maintain the works in good order or from the drifting or wreck of the works, the owner of the works shall be liable for any expense incurred in securing such assistance.
2. All associated equipment should be removed.

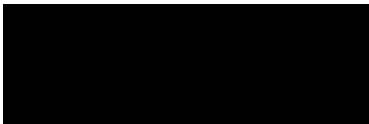

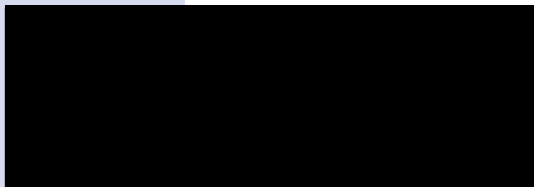
Northern Lighthouse board are content with the 'Removal of the Works' plan prepared for the discontinuing of the floating Lidar unit and that the plan meets with condition 3.2.4.4 of Marine Licence 06436/17/0.

We would require that a Notice to Mariners is promulgated informing the mariner of the discontinuing of the Lidar unit station, the Navigation light and the AIS transmission from the location.

The Statutory Sanction of the Northern Lighthouse Board will be required to discontinue these Aids to Navigation.

The radio licence obtained from OFCOM for the transmission of an AIS AtoN message may require to be surrendered and we would ask that the developers investigate this requirement.

Please advise if we can be of any further assistance, or require clarification any of the above.

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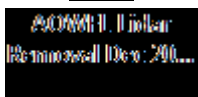

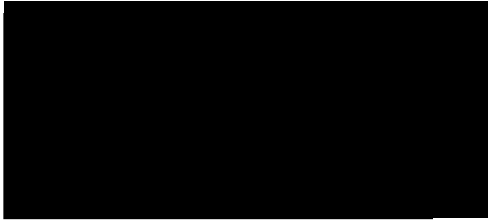
This information has been passed to SYSTRA Limited for review in their capacity as Term Consultant to Transport Scotland – Trunk Road and Bus Operations (TRBO). Based on the review undertaken, we would provide the following comments.

It is understood that Aberdeen Offshore Wind Farm Limited (AOWFL) are seeking a Marine License for the removal of the Babcock FORECAST Floating LiDAR Device (FLD) which was deployed on 30th October 2016. The removal of the device is scheduled for February 2018.

Transport Scotland was consulted on the Marine License application for the installation of the FLD, and provided comment in a letter dated 5th August 2016. In this, we noted that the LiDAR components would be transported using normal HGV loads and we concluded that the deployment of the device would not give rise to any environmental impacts on the trunk road network or any of its adjacent receptors. It is understood that the removal of the device involves the reverse methodology of that used for deployment.

Consequently, we can confirm that Transport Scotland has no objection to the proposed removal of the device, and does not require any further information in this regard.
