Whilst we have enclosed cable ties for this, we would recommend that you consider fixing the tags with a shackle. If for any reason the tag becomes detached, please contact this office for a replacement. The tag is valid until 31st December 2019.

A standing Order Mandate has been enclosed. If you wish to pay your annual fee by Standing Order please complete this form and send it to your bank for processing.

In the event you wish to terminate the licence (and remove the moorings) or transfer ownership of the mooring(s) to another party, please complete the enclosed "Termination Form" and return it to this office. Please note for transfers of ownership, your licence will remain in full force and effect until a new agreement has been signed by the new tenant.

Our Community Marine Officers are happy to provide advice and assistance on any mooring related issue and regularly visit mooring locations around the coast.
