Thank you for your correspondence of 13 March 2019 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") give their written approval to of the updated Development Specification and Layout Plan ("DSLP") (Document Reference: 8460001-PCA0010-MWE-REP-003) (issued 13 March 2019).

A previous version of the DSLP (issued 17 August 2018), received multi-stage and regulatory consent from MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, in a letter dated 2 November 2018 and deemed it to be fully compliant with condition 12 of the Section 36 Consents, condition 3.2.2.6 of the Offshore Transmission Infrastructure ("OfTI") Marine Licence (licence number: 05340/14/0)







and condition 3.2.2.7 of the Offshore Substation Platform ("OSP") Marine Licence (licence number: 06347/17/1), subject to it being implemented.
