I refer to your correspondence dated 25 August 2022 in which the Company submitted an updated PEMP to Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") for written approval in accordance with condition 23 of the section 36 consent (as varied) and condition 3.2.2.14 of the Offshore Transmission Infrastructure marine licence.

The PEMP received regulatory approval from MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers in a letter dated 26 June 2020.

MS-LOT has consulted with NatureScot (operating name of Scottish Natural Heritage), the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, Whale and Dolphin Conservation and Fisheries Management Scotland, as members of the Forth and Tay Regional Advisory Group, on 15 September 2022. Following consultation the Company submitted a final version of the PEMP dated 01 December 2022 for approval.

MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers approve the revised PEMP dated 01 December 2022.

Any further updates or amendments made to the PEMP, including any amendments to its appendices, must be submitted to the Scottish Ministers by the Company, in writing for written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.







Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Scottish Ministers, all activites must proceed in accordance with the approved PEMP.
