Moray Offshore Renewables Limited (Telford Offshore Wind Farm, Stevenson Offshore Wind Farm and MacColl Offshore Wind Farm formerly MORL, now Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited “Moray East”)

Section 36 Consents (as varied): Condition 17 (part f.)

Offshore Substation Platform Marine Licence: Condition 3.2.2.18

Offshore Transmission Infrastructure Marine Licence: Condition 3.2.2.9 (part f.)

Thank you for your correspondence dated 31 October 2018 requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) give their written approval to the Emergency Response Cooperation Plan (“ERCoP”) for the Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited (“Moray East”). Acceptance of the ERCoP will satisfy the requirements of condition 17 (part f.) of the Section 36 Consents for the MacColl Offshore Windfarm, Stevenson Offshore Windfarm and Telford Offshore Windfarm, condition 3.2.2.18 of the Offshore Substation Platform (“OSP”) Marine Licence (licence number: 06347/17/1) and condition 3.2.2.9 (part f.) of the Offshore Transmission Infrastructure (“OfTI”) Marine Licence (licence number: 05340/14/0).

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, have consulted with the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (“MCA”) and the Northern Lighthouse Board (“NLB”), and can confirm that the submitted ERCoP fulfils the requirements of, and is sufficient to discharge condition 17 (part f.) of the Section

36 Consents, condition 3.2.2.18 of the OSP Marine Licence and condition 3.2.2.9 (part f.) of the OfTI Marine Licence, subject to it being implemented.

The ERCoP is a live document, and it will be updated or amended by the Company, as and when new relevant information becomes available. Any updates or amendments made to this ERCoP by the Company, must be submitted in writing by the Company to the Scottish Ministers for their written approval.
