Thank you for your consultation of 7 May 2019, seeking our comments on the Written Scheme of Investigation and the Protocol for Archaeological Discoveries for the Beatrice Offshore Windfarm to satisfy the relevant conditions of consent.

We have reviewed the submitted documents in terms of our historic environment interests. We note that both *Appendix C: Protocol for Infringement of Archaeological Exclusion Zone* and *Appendix D: Protocol for Reporting Finds of Archaeological Interest* use the term 'Environmental Advisor' within the flow chart detailing the roles and responsibilities in the PAD process, in the event of an archaeological discovery. However, we have not found the explanation of this term within the Glossary or the flow chart in the submitted documents. We would therefore request that this term is clarified before we can confirm that the documents fully satisfy the conditions of consent.
