In our area there are no Historical MPAs, Designated vessels, Controlled sites, Listed Buildings or Scheduled Monuments. In our cove we do not impinge on any sea or shellfish fishery, aquaculture, wild salmon or diadromous (migratory) fish, or any oil or gas or carbon capture and storage, or offshore wind or renewable energy facility. Recreation and tourism will not be threatened, neither will shipping or transport and we are not within a harbour boundary. We know of no submarine cables or of any Defence implications. We believe no one wishes to extract aggregates from the site and we have no intention of doing so ourselves. Apart from a very occasional small canoe I have seen no vessel navigating in the vicinity of our mooring in the last ten years.
