I refer to your correspondence dated 31 July 2024 in which the Company submitted revisions to the ERCoP dated 25 July 2024.

The ERCoP received multi stage regulatory consent from the Marine Directorate - Licensing Operations Team (“MD-LOT”) on behalf of the Scottish Ministers in a letter dated 14 May 2020.

MD-LOT has consulted with the National Lighthouse Board and the Maritime and Coastguard Agency on the ERCoP and no update was required.

MD-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers approve the ERCoP dated 25 July 2024.

Any further updates or amendments made to the ERCoP, including any amendments to its appendices, must be submitted to the Scottish Ministers by the Company, in writing for written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Scottish Ministers all activities must proceed in accordance with the approved ERCoP.
