Navigational Safety Plan and Vessel Management Plan (“NSVMP”)

I refer to your correspondence dated 19 January 2026 in which the Company submitted a revision to the NSVMP dated 5 January 2026.

MD-LOT has consulted with Forth Ports, the Maritime and Coastguard Agency, NatureScot, the Northern Lighthouse Board, the Scottish Fishermen’s Federation and the Whale and Dolphin Conservation on the revised NSVMP. Following consultation, the Company submitted a final version of the revised NSVMP on 28 April 2026 for approval.

MD-LOT on behalf of the Licensing Authority approve the revised NSVMP dated 27 April 2026.

Any further updates or amendments made to the revised NSVMP, including any amendments to its appendices, must be submitted to the Licensing Authority by the Company, in writing for written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Licensing Authority all activities must proceed in accordance with the approved revised NSVMP.
