I refer to correspondence dated 16 March 2021 submitting a revised Piling Strategy to the Scottish Ministers for written approval.

A previous version of the Piling Strategy received multi-stage and regulatory consent from Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") on behalf of the Scottish Ministers in a decision notice dated 29 May 2020.

No concerns were raised following consultation with NatureScot (operating name of Scottish Natural Heritage), Whale and Dolphin Conservation, River Tweed Commission and Scottish Borders Council on the revised Piling Strategy.

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, hereby approve the revised Piling Strategy as submitted on 16 March 2021.
