Offshore Transmission Asset Marine Licence (Licence Number: 04678/19/0): condition 3.2.1.2 – Written Scheme of Investigation ("WSI")

I refer to your letter dated 10 October 2019 submitting a Marine Archaeology WSI and Protocol for Archaeolgical Dicoveries ("PAD") (as referred to in the consents as a MARP and the marine licence as a WSI) for written approval.

Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, consulted with Historic Environment Scotland ("HES"). HES confirmed that they are content with the WSI and PAD.
