Moray Offshore Renewables Limited (Telford Offshore Wind Farm, Stevenson Offshore Wind Farm and MacColl Offshore Wind Farm formally MORL, now Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited "Moray East")

Offshore Generating Station Marine Licence – 3.1.12 Offshore Substation Platforms Marine Licence – Condition 3.2.1.8 Offshore Transmission Infrastructure Marine Licence – Condition 3.1.12 (collectively referred to as "the Conditions")

Thank you for your correspondence requesting that Marine Scotland-Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") give its written approval to the revised Marine Pollution Contingency Plan ("MPCP") issued February 2021.

Two previous versions of the MPCP (issued September 2018 and December 2020, respectively) received multi-stage consent and regulatory approval from MS-LOT, on behalf of Scottish Ministers, in letters dated 02 November 2018 and 20 January 2021, respectively, which deemed them sufficient to fully discharge the conditions, subject to them being fully implemented.

MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers can confirm that based on the information detailed within the revised MPCP that Moray East is in compliance with the Conditions.

MS-LOT therefore confirms its approval of the revised MPCP issued February 2021. Any further updates or amendments made to the MPCP (including updates to any of its appendices), must be submitted in writing by Moray East to the Scottish Ministers for its written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.
