**CONSENT GRANTED BY THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE THE MEYGEN TIDAL ENERGY PROJECT ELECTRICITY GENERATING STATION IN THE INNER SOUND, PENTLAND FIRTH**

Thank you for providing Revision 2 of the *Construction Method Statement* which covers the installation of the Phase 1a infrastructure (4 x Tidal Turbine Generators (TTG), 4 x Gravity-base Turbine Support Structures (TSS) and Turbine Subsea Cables (TSC)), collectively described as “the Construction Works”, on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2015.
