Notice is hereby given that Caledonia Offshore Wind Farm Limited, registered under company registration 13844888 at C/O Shepherd and Wedderburn LLP, 1-6 Lombard Street, London, England, EC3V 9AA, has been granted by the Scottish Ministers:

- consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989; and
- marine licences under section 20 of the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010 and section 65 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009.

each with conditions attached, to construct and operate an offshore wind farm (including associated transmission assets) in the outer Moray Firth, approximately 45 kilometres from the Wick coastline and 35 kilometres from the Banff coastline, with a total area of 204.5 square kilometres (central latitude and longitude co-ordinates: 58°7.814'N 2°25.285'W (WGS84)).

The anticipated installed capacity of the proposed generating station will be between 900 and 1,100 Megawatts comprising up to 78 wind turbine generators with a maximum height of 355 metres above Mean Sea Level. The proposed generating station will provide renewable electricity to the national grid.
