Offshore Transmission Infrastructure Cable Plan (“OTA CaP”)

I refer to your correspondence dated 18 November 2022 in which the Company submitted the OTA CaP dated 16 November 2022.

The OTA CaP received multi-stage regulatory approval from the Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) on behalf of the Scottish Ministers in a letter dated 17 November 2020.

MS-LOT has consulted with the Ministry of Defence, the Joint Nature Conservation Committee, NatureScot, the Maritime Coastguard Agency, and the Scottish Fisherman’s Federation on the 07 December 2022 and no update was required.

The licensing authority approve the revised OTA CaP dated 16 November 2022.

Any further updates or amendments made to the OTA CaP, including any amendments to its appendices, must be submitted to the licensing authority by the Company, in writing for written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the licensing authority, all activities must proceed in accordance with the approved OTA CaP.
