There have been moorings in Cronin Harbour for many decades and Cronin Harbour Association has been managing the moorings and the facilities since 1988. With reference to General Policies 1-21, CHA provides facilities for recreational boating which supports local employment and offers other economic benefits; users of the moorings include both local people and other from outside the area. (Gen 2, 3 & 7) We provide a rubbish skip for use by mariners (Gen 11). CHA is in a Nature Conservation Marine Protected Area and a Marine Special Area of Conservation in Scottish Waters and we do not believe that our activities make a significant impact on the marine environment (Gen 9)
