**Offshore Windfarm Construction Method Statement (“OWF CMS”)**

I refer to your correspondence dated 13 March 2023 in which the Company submitted a revision to the OWF CMS dated 13 March 2023.

The OWF CMS received multi-stage regulatory consent from the Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) on behalf of the Scottish Ministers in a letter dated 01 July 2020.

MS-LOT has consulted with the Maritime and Coastguard Agency, the Northern Lighthouse Board, NatureScot, the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds Scotland, Angus Council

and the Scottish Environment Protection Agency on the revised OWF CMS and no update was required.

MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers approve the revised OWF CMS dated 13 March 2023.

Any further updates or amendments made to the revised OWF CMS, including any amendments to its appendices, must be submitted to the Scottish Ministers by the Company, in writing for written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Scottish Ministers all activities must proceed in accordance with the approved revised OWF CMS.
