Thank you for your email inviting the Maritime and Coastguard Agency to comment on the application for the proposed pontoon at Fraserburgh Harbour for the Moray East Offshore Windfarm. We have reviewed the documents received, and confirm we have no objections to a licence being granted. This is on the understanding that all maritime safety legislation is adhered to, and that the following risk mitigation measures take place:

Conditions:

1. The Licencee must ensure that HM Coastguard, in this case nmoccontroller@hmcg.gov.uk, The National Maritime Operations Centre is made aware of the works prior to commencement.

Advisories:

- 1) The Consent Holder should ensure suitable bunding, storage facilities are employed to prevent the release of fuel oils, lubricating fluids associated with the plant and equipment into the marine environment.
- 2) The site is within port limits and the applicant should gain the approval/agreement of the responsible local navigation authority or the Harbour Authority/Commissioners/Council. They may wish to issue local warnings to alert those navigating in the vicinity to the presence of the works, as deemed necessary.

This is to ensure the local harbour/navigation authority are able to maintain their responsibilities and obligations to maintain the safety of navigation under the Port Marine Safety Code and its Guide to Good Practice.

MORAY OFFSHORE WINDFARM (EAST) LIMITED – NEW PONTOON – FRASERBURGH HARBOUR

With reference to your recent consultation request on the above development, this information has been passed to SYSTRA Limited for consideration in their capacity as Term Consultants to Transport Scotland – Roads Directorate. Based on the review of information available on the Marine Scotland website, we would provide the following comments.

Proposed Development

We understand that the proposal comprises a new pontoon at Fraserburgh Harbour, which will be up to 67m long and up to 4m wide. The site location is in the south harbour, approximately 1.6km from the A90(T).

The supporting documentation indicates that construction of the pontoon will involve the delivery of the pontoon as modules by truck to the harbour. Each module will be lifted by crane, which will be located onshore, placed in the water and then towed into place. Once in place, each module will be secured to the side of the dock via pre-installed H-beams. We note there will be no piling carried out and we assume there will be no requirement for dredging.

Given the site location and the modest scale of development, Transport Scotland considers there to be no requirement for any detailed assessment of trunk road impacts associated with increased traffic from the works. Taking this into account, Transport Scotland has no objection to the proposed application in terms of environmental impacts on the trunk road network.
