Attention is also directed to the provisions of Section 23(10) of the 1951 Act and Section 6(1) of the 1965 Act which provide that if an applicant is aggrieved by the refusal of a River Purification Authority to consent to an application or by the terms of any such consent, he may within three months of his receipt of the decision on his application appeal in writing to the Secretary of State.

- 5. The outlet shall be by a 9" cast iron pipe.
