I refer to correspondence dated 9 November 2021 submitting a revised Construction Programme ("CoP") to the Scottish Ministers for written approval in accordance with condition 3.2.2.3 of the offshore transmission marine licence (as varied).

A previous version of the CoP received approval from Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") on behalf of the Scottish Ministers on 26 October 2021.

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, hereby approve the amended CoP following consultation with NatureScot, the Northern Lighthouse Board, the Maritime Coastguard Agency, the Ministry of Defence, Scottish Environment Protection Agency, the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, Carnoustie Golf Links Management Committee, Angus Council, Dundee City Council, Fife Council, East Lothian Council and the Scottish Borders Council.
