MARINE (SCOTL AND) ACT 2010, PART 4 MARINE LICENSING

MARINE LICENCE 04309/18/3 LICENCE FOR MARINE RENEWABLES CONSTRUCTION WORKS AND DEPOSITS OF SUBSTANCES OR OBJECTS IN THE SCOTTISH MARINE AREA

Condition 3.2.2.4 Marking, lighting and signals of the works.

Condition 3.2.2.5 Marking, Lighting and Signals of Jack up Barges and Vessels.

Thank you for your correspondence of 13th September 2018, requesting that Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") give their written confirmation that the requirements of Conditions 3.2.2.4 and 3.2.2.5 of the Marine Licence for the European Offshore Wind Deployment Centre ("EOWDC") (licence number: 04309/18/3, have been fully satisfied.

Conditions 3.2.2.4

The Licensee must ensure that the Works are marked and lit in accordance with the requirements of the NLB and the current CAA Policy and Guidance at all times and such marking and/or lighting must be continued unless and until such time as the Licensing Authority, by notice, relevantly varies this licence under section 30 of the 2010 Act.

Conditions 3.2.2.5

The Licensee must ensure that any jack up barges and vessels used during the Works must, when jacked up, exhibit signals in accordance with the UK Standard Marking Schedule for Offshore Installations.

In a meeting on the 12th September 2018 you informed MS-LOT that EOWDC had fulfilled all of the requirements of conditions 3.2.2.4 and 3.2.2.5 and now that the construction phase of the project had concluded requested that the conditions be discharged.

MS-LOT can confirm, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, that all of the requirements of conditions 3.2.2.4 and 3.2.2.5 of EOWDC's Marine Licence (Licence Number: 04309/18/3) have been fulfilled and Conditions 3.2.2.4 and 3.2.2.5 of this Marine Licence are now discharged.
