Eastern Green Link 2 Marine Scheme

Pre-Application Consultation Events

Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission (SHE Transmission) and National Grid Energy Transmission (NGET) invite you to come and share your views with us.

SHE Transmission and NGET, the prospective applicants, hereby give notice of our Pre-Application Consultation (PAC) events to be undertaken in advance of the submission to Marine Scotland of an application for Marine Licences for the installation of the Eastern Green Link 2 Marine Scheme in Scottish waters. The Marine Scheme includes approximately 440km of subsea High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC) cables, fibre optic cable and associated cable protection from Mean High Water Springs at Sandford Bay, Peterhead to Fraisthorpe Sands, England. These events will focus on the elements of the Marine Scheme which are located in Scottish waters.

SHE Transmission would like to extend an invitation to local members of the community and all interested parties to attend an exhibition to discuss our plans with the project team and let us know your thoughts on our proposals.

How to get involved?

A face to face public exhibition will take place on Wednesday 6th April 2022 at Peterhead Football Club between 2pm-7pm. This is an open door drop in session open to all members of the public and interested parties.

A further two online consultation events will take place on Thursday 7th April between 1pm-3pm & 5-7pm.

The online virtual consultation events have been designed to be fully interactive, allowing for presentation of key project information and plans, as well as providing an opportunity to ask questions about the project. Visitors will be able to engage directly with the project team via an instant message function, where they can ask any questions they might have about the project and share their feedback on the current proposals.
