## **MARINE (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010, PART 4 MARINE LICENSING**

### **MARINE LICENCE 06573/18/1;**

#### **Condition 3.1.6, Chemical Usage**

#### **Condition 3.1.7, Fluorinated greenhouse gases**

Thank you for your email dated 9<sup>th</sup> February 2018 providing Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") with information concerning condition 3.1.6 - Chemical Usage and condition 3.1.7 - Fluorinated greenhouse gases of the LiDAR Removal Marine Licence ("licence number: 06573/18/1") for Aberdeen Offshore Windfarm Limited ("AOWFL").

In regard to condition 3.1.6 you stated that the *"Contractor has confirmed no proposed use of operational chemicals, or chemicals in closed systems specifically required to complete works."* Moreover, in support of condition 3.1.7 you added *"Contractor has confirmed no fluorinated greenhouse gases are required to complete works."*

MS-LOT, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, are content that AOWFL have confirmed that no chemicals nor fluorinated greenhouse gases will be used to remove the LiDAR device, and therefore condition 3.1.6 and condition 3.1.7 of the LiDAR Removal Marine Licence ("licence number: 06573/18/1"), are now discharged.

Should any chemicals be used it is the responsibility of AOWFL to notify the Scottish Ministers on the changes immediately.
