Thank you for your correspondence dated 23 April 2019 regarding the Emergency Response Co-operation Plan ("ERCoP") amendments, in respect of tranche 2 of the Kincardine Floating Offshore Windfarm ("the Development").

The submitted ERCoP has met the requirements of and is in compliance with condition 3.2.1.4 of the Marine Licence (licence number: 05914/18/1) in respect of tranche 2 of the Development and part (f) of condition 16 of the section 36 Consent ("s.36"). Kincardine Offshore Windfarm Limited discussed and developed the proposed ERCoP with the Marine and Coastguard Agency ("MCA").

The MCA, in the correspondence dated 18 June 2019, confirmed that *"they have no concerns to raise with this document, and continues to liaise with the developer to ensure the ERCoP remains up to date and fit for purpose"*.

MS-LOT can confirm, on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, that the submitted ERCoP fulfils the requirements of, and is in compliance with condition 3.2.1.4 of the Marine
