LIGHTING AND MARKING PLAN

I refer to your correspondence dated 15 February 2023 in which the Company submitted Revision 7 of the Lighting and Marking Plan ("LMP") to Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team ("MS-LOT") for written approval in accordance with the conditions.

In light of the minor changes to the LMP, MS-LOT have not undertaken a full consultation and have referred to the submitted correspondence from both the Northern Lighthouse Board and the Civil Aviation Authority, where they have indicated they have no objections to the amendments.

The LMP received multi-stage regulatory consent from MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers in a letter dated 28 January 2020.

MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers approve the revised LMP dated February 2023.

Any further updates or amendments made to the LMP, including any amendments to its appendices, must be submitted to the Scottish Ministers by the Company, in writing for written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.







Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Scottish Ministers all activities must proceed in accordance with the approved LMP.
