Application to Disturb Marine Species, Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited

Further to your application received 3 December 2018 in relation to Unexploded Ordnance ("UXO") clearance at the site of the proposed Moray East Wind Farm and Offshore Transmission Infrastructure Cable Corridor, I can inform you that the conditions for issue of a licence have been met and a copy of the licence, MS EPS 02/2019/0 is enclosed. I am obliged to draw your attention to the conditions contained within the licence, as detailed by our advisors. Under *The Conservation (Natural Habitats, &c.)
