DEVELOPMENT SPECIFICATION AND LAYOUT PLAN

I refer to your correspondence dated 17 October 2022 in which the Company submitted the Development Specification and Layout Plan (DSLPL) dated 17 October 2022.

The DSLPL received multi-stage regulatory approval and consent from the Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) on behalf of the Scottish Ministers in a letter dated 27 September 2022.

MS-LOT has consulted with NatureScot, Royal Yachting Association Scotland, the Maritime and Coastguard Agency, Northern Lighthouse Board, Ministry of Defence, Civil Aviation Authority, Scottish Fishermen’s Federation, Aberdeenshire Council, Moray Council, the

Highland Council and Joint Radio Company. Following consultation no update to the revised DSLP was required.

MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers approve the DSLP dated 17 October 2022.

Any further updates or amendments made to the DSLP, including any amendments to its appendices, must be submitted to the Scottish Ministers by the Company, in writing for written approval prior to the planned implementation of the proposed amendments or updates.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Scottish Ministers, all activities must proceed in accordance with the approved DSLP.
