Thank you for your correspondence on 15 March 2022 requesting that the Marine Scotland-Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) confirm approval of the Written Scheme of Investigation (“WSI”) and Protocol for Archaeological Discoveries (“PAD”) for Moray Offshore Windfarm (West) Limited (“Moray West”) in line with the Conditions.
